Additionally, it prioritizes staff training and involves the public in seeking opinions before undertaking construction projects. This commitment reflects its dedication to good governance, aiming for positive outcomes for citizens and the nation. Furthermore, the Department of Rural Roads recognizes the urgency of addressing corruption, emphasizing the importance of effectively preventing and combating corrupt practices and misconduct.

Hence, to strongly oppose corruption in all its forms and to reinforce ethics, morality, and integrity in carrying out duties, thereby ensuring transparency in the organization's operations and building public trust, the Department of Rural Roads hereby declares the following commitment. The management, officials, and all personnel within the organization will refuse any gifts or forms of compensation before, during, or after the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy). This policy aims to prevent corruption and misconduct, ensuring fair conduct and avoiding any undue benefits. Additionally, this commitment involves fostering awareness and instilling good values in duties. It is encouraged to express gratitude through greeting cards or social media platforms instead of offering physical gifts. Directors and employers at all levels are expected to set a high standard and supervise their employees.
